Sophisticated Patio Heaters for the 21st Century!

While mushroom-topped, pole-mounted patio heaters have their place outdoors, there are other patronwarming heaters that provide more uniform heat, offer more mounting options and eliminate all those poles, base plates and propane tanks. Calcana builds and sells nothing but infrared strip heaters. While strip heaters have been around for years warming garage bays and loading docks, Calcana has dressed them up, made them more effective, efficient and perfect for a broad range of restaurant and hospitality industry outdoor heating applications.

The Calcana Line of Outdoor Patio Heaters includes their PH-40, PH-50 and PH-75 Models, plus PH-40HO and PH-75HO "high output" Models. The base PH Series are 10-, 15 and 20-feet long, with 40.000, 50,000 and 75,000 BTU/hr. maximum heat output,



respectively. The high output models are also rated for 40,000 BTU/hr. or 75,000 BTU/hr., but only half as long at five and ten feet, respectively. All Calcana patio heaters are available for use with either natural gas or liquid propane gas.

Their infrared strip-type heaters are attractive yet discrete, with an aluminized combustion tube, aluminum standard reflector, all stainless steel hangers, a stainless steel burner head and decorative protective grille. All stainless steel construction is an available option. They are designed for either wall/bracket mounting, or post and track overhead mounting.

Calcana outdoor heaters are unique in offering modulating (variable) heat control. This patent-pending control system allows you to adjust heat level to current outdoor conditions, for guest comfort and potential energy (fuel) savings. A simple wall-mounted low-voltage control has an ON/OFF power switch that activates pilotless electronic ignition and a HI/LOW variable heat control.

Thinking Outside the Patio

While foodservice applications for outdoor heating are often limited to bar and dining areas, Calcana heaters are also used for nightclub velvet-rope "waiting lines", outdoor smoking areas (where legal), doorman and valet parking stations and outdoor pool and hot tub areas.

Now Made in the USA Too

For over two decades, Calcana has built their heaters in Calgary, Alberta, Canada; but in November of 2011, Calcana USA Ltd. opened a second manufacturing facility in Loxley, Alabama to better serve the needs of their "Lower-48" customer base. Building heaters in Alabama improves product availability, reduces transportation costs and provides jobs and a boost to the local economy.
